Hands on Huntington, a Neighborhood Naturally Occurring Retirement Community program, is a program provided at no cost to seniors age 60 years and older.

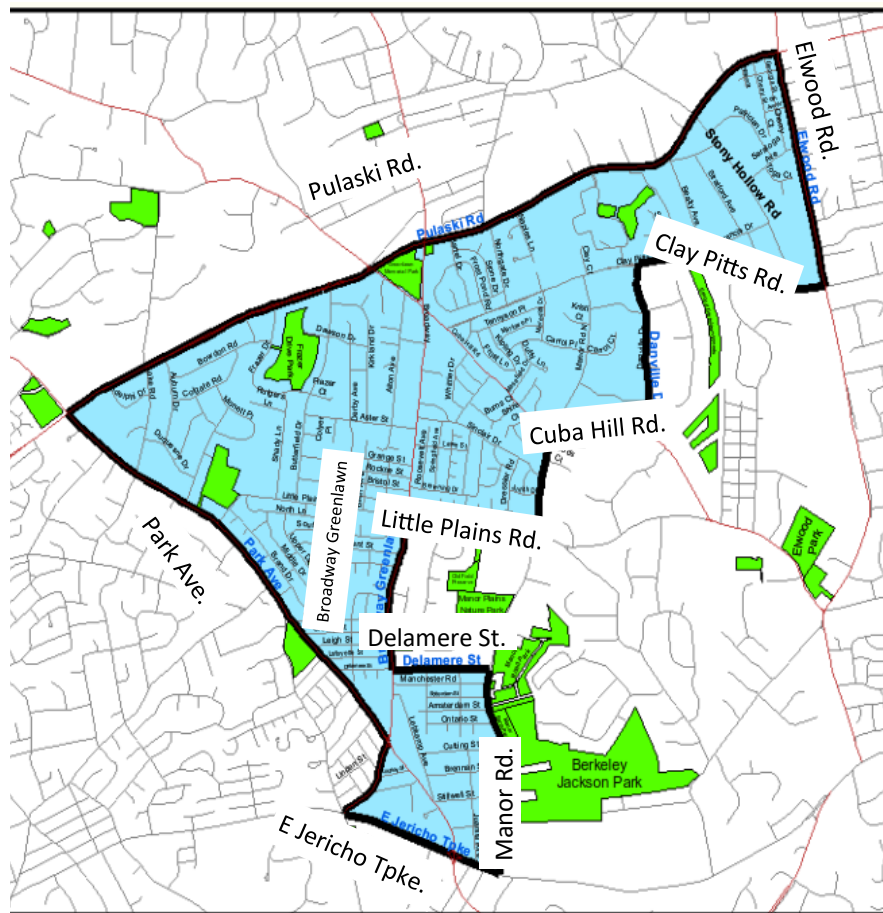

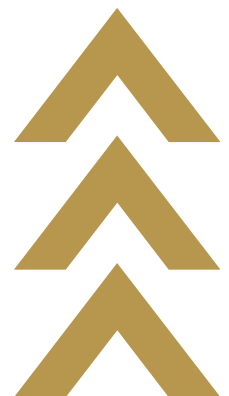

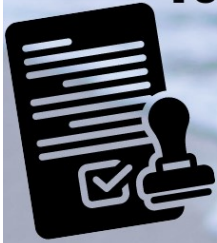

Professional individuals working with adults **60 years of age and older** may refer cases to the E-MDT if elder abuse is suspected. The E-MDT reviews such cases and assists through a *trauma-informed collaborative approach* to stopping the abuse. Social workers, case managers, medical or legal professionals, law enforcement, and any other service providers can refer a case to the EMDT to receive *creative solutions* to return the older adult to a state of stability and safety.
