The Town of Huntington Public Art Advisory Committee invites teen writers (ages 14-18) residing and/or attending school in the Town of Huntington to submit up to three poems that they have written for possible inclusion in HART ART, a Public Art Initiative Teen Poetry Project.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Submit six (6) copies of each poem (unless submitting online at www.HuntingtonNY.gov/HARTpoetry).
- Poems must be in English, titled, no more than 30 lines long, and typed or neatly printed. (Maximum of 3 poems per poet)
- Each poem, if NOT submitted online, must be accompanied by a completed entry form with valid address (see below).
- To preserve anonymity during review process, do NOT include your name on your poem, only on the entry form.
- Entries will NOT be returned.
- Optional Category: Poetry and Art. If desired, poems may be inspired by an artwork on view in the Locally Sourced: Collecting Long Island Artists "exhibition at The Heckscher Museum of Art (2 Prime Avenue, Huntington – www.heckscher.org). Entries in this category

must provide on the entry form the artist's name and title of the artwork that served as inspiration. Call 631.351.2873 for more information. *FREE Museum admission for one adult and one teen upon mention of "HART ART."

DEADLINE: Poems must be received by **February 21, 2020** at address above (online submission available at www.HuntingtonNY.gov/HARTpoetry, submission by fax or e-mail NOT allowed).

SELECTION PROCESS:

A panel composed of poets, youth group leaders, and Public Art Advisory Committee members will review all submissions and select winning poems based on the following criteria

- Quality and creativity of the writing
- Age of the poet

- Appropriateness of content for public display
- Relationship to artwork (Optional Category: Poetry and Art ONLY)

AWARDS - Winners will receive the following benefits beginning in April 2020 (National Poetry Month):

- Recognition at public reception and opportunity to participate in a poetry reading with professional poet mentors.
- Poem posted in the Public Art Inventory on the Town of Huntington's website (see www.HuntingtonNY.gov/HARTpoetry).
- Poem displayed in interior advertising spaces of HART buses for at least one year.
- Poem published in The Long Islander newspaper.
- Poem displayed in The Heckscher Museum of Art (Optional Category: Poetry and Art ONLY).
