THE BEACH HOUSE HISTORY

The original part of this house was erected *circa* 1782 and was the first farmhouse in the area. Farmland and pasture fields, including the present Vanderbilt property, surrounded the farmhouse.

The name of the original owner is not known, but it was purchased about 1850 by Phineas Sills of Northport. For a while, the area was called Sills Point. According to old records, Mr. Sills was active in Revolutionary War affairs and owned the Northport Fire, Sand and Brick Company, which dug much of it's clay from pits a half mile south of the house, on what is now Mariners Court. Mr. Sills enlarged the house, called it "Glen House" and used it as a summer boarding house. At the time, about 40 other homes in Centerport accommodated approximately 500 summer guests.

In 1885, the house was bought by Samuel T. Carter and remained in his family until 1920. The last family member to own it was Reverend Samuel T. Carter, Jr., Pastor of the Old First Church of Huntington. He had eleven children and many grandchildren who used the house extensively as a summer residence until it was sold to Robert Kessler. In 1963, he sold it to the Town of Huntington for \$87,000.00. It then became the Senior Citizens Beach House.

BEACH HOUSE RULES for Beach House, Cottage, Pavilion & Grounds

PLEASE COOPERATE BY OBSERVING THE FOLLOWING:

- Guests who are senior citizens and who do not reside in the Town of Huntington are welcome for one visit during the season.
- Children are welcome on the Beach House grounds during designated events.
- **SMOKING, ALCOHOL & PETS** are prohibited on the Beach House premises (including pavilion, cottage, and grounds).
- Cover-ups must be worn over dry bathing suits in the Beach House or Cottage; wet bathing suits are prohibited.
- Bathing suit changing must be done in the Cabana only; no changing in the bathrooms.
- All game equipment must be returned to the Beach House by 3:30 p.m.
- **PARKING** is permitted in designated Centerport Beach area only. Do not park in the staff driveway. Do not park on the grass.
- Only staff is permitted on the second floor or in the basement of the Beach House or Cottage.
- **FREE BEACH PARKING STICKERS** are **not** available at the Beach House or Cottage. Please call the Department of Parks and Recreation at 631-351-3089 for more information.
- Please leave the flowers for others to enjoy.
- Beach House or Cottage telephone may be used for emergency calls only.
- **FISHING** is prohibited on Beach House grounds and waters.
- Please discard trash in appropriate receptacles in the buildings and on the grounds.
- Any boat utilizing a Senior Boat Rack must have a valid decal affixed as proof of Senior Division registration.

In addition, please follow “Principles & Rules of Conduct for use of Senior Facilities & Programs” at all times.
