Join us as we tour Manhattan and explore some of the things that make New York great. Our restroom-equipped coach departs Huntington Senior Center at 7:30 am SHARP!

Our first stop is the renowned Chelsea Market. One of the greatest indoor food halls of the world, with more than thirty-five vendors offering everything from soup to nuts, wine to coffee, and cheese to cheesecake. Chelsea Market attracts over 6 million visitors annually. We have at least an hour to shop or take a walk along the High Line.

After the market, we proceed to Da Rosina Ristorante Italiano on Restaurant Row. Lunch is served offering a wide choice of appetizers, entrées and desserts. Soft drinks are served during lunch, with coffee and tea served during dessert.

Continuing on, we will meet up and board THE TOUR powered by THE RIDE. The bus navigates a 90-minute route exploring over ten NYC neighborhoods and 50 landmarks, including Lincoln Center, Central Park, Fifth Avenue, Rockefeller Center, Radio City Music Hall, the Garment District, Empire State Building, Times Square, Columbus Circle, Madison Avenue, New York Public Library, Bryant Park, and the famous Forty-Second Street, to name just a few. With a full wall of glass that extends well into the roof, everyone has a great view, sitting theatre style in several rows. Please note, this bus requires more steps than others.

Join us for a relaxing day trip to the banks of the Delaware River. Just 2-1/2 hours from home you'll find two historic towns... Lambertville in New Jersey and New Hope in Pennsylvania.

We begin east of the river in Lambertville, at the historic Lambertville Station Restaurant. Lambertville is the only city in Hunterdon County, and one of the smallest cities in the U.S. Lunch includes: soft drinks, salad, choice of entrée (Pasta Primavera, Maple-mustard Salmon or Tender Top Sirloin), coffee, tea and dessert. After lunch, we cross the river into New Hope.

In 2015, Coldwell Banker reported that New Hope had the most expensive real estate market in PA and the 86th most expensive market in the United States. It is also home to the Bucks County Playhouse, where we will see "CLUE". Based on the popular board game and the classic film, CLUE is a comedy "whodunit" where the audience decides the outcome. Six unique guests, a butler and a maid are all involved in the murders of six people. With hilarious jokes and characters of the original film, CLUE will keep you guessing and laughing till the very end.

Free time after the show allows you to browse the town of New Hope where you'll find antiques, ice cream, coffee shops, boutique shops, book stores and more all within a short walking distance. New Hope is so full of history and charm, you'll want to come back again.
