- Capable of performing 8 hours of physical labor each day
- Have a valid driver's license
- Willing to travel to job sites throughout Long Island and New York City
- Be 18 years or older
- Legally eligible to work in the US
- Able to pass a reading and math test at the 8th grade level
- Possess a High School Diploma, GED or TASC at the time of application
- Able to pass a drug test
- Be unemployed or have a low income
- Able to attend class Monday through Friday from 7 AM to 5 PM and occasional Saturdays
