



### **Town of Huntington Annual Gingerbread House Contest**

- 1) All houses should be made out of handmade gingerbread-the use of gingerbread house kits shall not be permitted.
- 2) Decorations on, inside or surrounding the house must be 100% edible, with the exception of battery powered lights.
- 3) Houses should sit on a base of 20" x 20" inches of ¼ inch plywood and should be sturdy enough to be moved, if necessary. Houses and base should not exceed 20" in height. Ribbon and other non-edible materials may be used to decorate the sides of the base only.
- 4) No identifying marks, names or logos may be used.
- 5) Eligible participants: a) commercial bakeries in the Town of Huntington.  
b) home baker category.

### **Rules and Information:**

- 1) Applications must be submitted in person, by regular mail or by email to Will Healy at Huntington Town Hall, 100 Main Street, Huntington, New York 11743 or [whealy@huntingtonny.gov](mailto:whealy@huntingtonny.gov).
- 2) All Applications must be submitted no later than November 7, 2016.
- 3) Applicants will be notified of the location, date and time where Gingerbread Houses are to be delivered for selection of the ten (10) finalists in each category.
- 4) The five finalist Gingerbread Houses in each category will be displayed at locations, to be determined, in Huntington Village from November 21<sup>st</sup> through November 26<sup>th</sup>. The general public will vote for the best Gingerbread House in each category from noon until 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 26, 2016. The winners will be announced following the Parade and prior to the Annual Tree Lighting.
- 5) All finalist Gingerbread Houses will be transported to town Hall and will remain on display through the holiday season.
