Councilman Mark Cuthbertson

wants all existing homeowners as of 3/1/13 receiving a Basic STAR property tax exemption to know you must register with the New York State Tax Department in order to receive the exemption on the December 2014 tax bill. The registration requirement is not satisfied by your original application to the Town assessor.

- Senior citizens receiving the Enhanced Star exemption are not affected by the new registration requirement.
- Homeowners purchasing a home after 3/1/13, who are applying for the Basic STAR exemption do not need to register this year.

How to register Online

What you will need:

- a STAR code (NY State has mailed codes to all Basic STAR recipients; or you can use the STAR code lookup)
- the names and social security numbers for all owners of the property and spouses
- to confirm that the property is the primary residence of one of its owners (married couples with multiple residences may only claim one STAR exemption)
- to confirm that the combined income of the owners and their spouses who reside at the property does not exceed \$500,000
- and confirm that no resident owner received a residency-based tax benefit from another state
