PRE-SCHOOL PROGRAM

A special program for the pre-school child that features music, arts & crafts, games, storytelling and special events, all under certified teachers and trained counselors. **Birth certificate required at the first day of the program to the teacher.**

Date & Time: July 5 to August 12, 2016 - Monday thru Friday
9 AM to 12 Noon - No program July 4th

Eligibility: **Must be 3 years old by June 1st** for 3 year program
Must be 4 years old by the start of the program
for 4/5 year program

BIRTH CERTIFICATE REQUIRED All children must be toilet-trained and cannot wear diapers or pull-ups.

Fees: 3 yr olds-\$275 w/Rec. ID - \$335 w/o Rec. ID
4/5 yr olds-\$270 w/Rec. ID - \$330 w/o Rec. ID

REGISTRATION FOR PRE-SCHOOL AND PLAYGROUNDS

Please note the locations are subject to change by the School District

ONLINE for 100% of the openings starting May 19th at 3 PM for Huntington residents only. Log onto huntingtonny.gov, then click on "Parks & Recreation", then click the Interactive Digital Brochure in the bottom right corner of brochure. The Playground/preschool information and activity #'s are on page 16-17. Use the activity numbers associated with each class and site listed. Please note that you do not have to register for a site based on your school district residency.

Any remaining openings will be available both online and in person starting May 26th at 9 AM.

Requests to place children together in the Pre-School Program must be made at the time of registration. When you register in person or online you will need to answer the question about placing children together. You will have to enter the other child's name and age. This is your only opportunity to make this request. You can only request to be placed with one (1) other child. Failure to meet these guidelines will result in the denial of your request.

Requests to place children together in the Playground Program is not done when you register. The groups are formed the first day of the program at each location by grades.

Birth certificates are required for all pre-school children. You **MUST** present it on the first day of the program to the pre-school teacher.

After registering online, print out your receipt so you will have the letter about the program and an emergency/medical form. Bring the completed emergency/medical form the first day of the program. **PLEASE DO NOT MAIL THE FORM.**
