Dear Parents:

Enclosed is an application for **returning campers** for Camp Bright Star. The camp will be held at Maplewood Intermediate School, Huntington Station, NY 11746.

The program will operate from Tuesday, July 3 to Friday, August 11, 2023. Program hours are 9AM to 2:30PM, Monday through Friday. The cost is \$320 with a Recreation ID card, and \$765 without a Recreation ID card. Enclosed is a flyer explaining the Recreation ID Card. Please make sure you check the expiration date on the Recreation ID card.

Transportation will again be provided for Huntington residents. Non-residents can access the bus transportation by dropping the camper off at a scheduled bus stop in Huntington.

Please complete the application, which includes a section to be completed by a physician. Include a check payable to the Department of Parks and Recreation.

The application and payment are due no later than Monday May 5, 2023. If you are missing certain information send the application anyway. You can submit the missing information at a later date. You will be placed on a waiting list if you don't submit the application by the deadline. Send this information to the Town of Huntington, Parks & Recreation Department, 100 Main Street, Huntington, NY 11743. ATT: Camp Bright Star.

If your child will be accompanied by a paraprofessional ("shadow") call at 351-3094 immediately for specific instructions. All requests must be made by May 12, 2023. NO requests will be accepted after this date.

The camp is required to have a permit from the New York State Health Department to operate. The Suffolk County Health Department inspects the camp twice a year. The inspection reports are filed with them at 360 Yaphank Avenue, Suite 2A, Yaphank, NY 11980.
