The CEHA maps have not been updated in quite some time, the old 'blue line' maps are the legal documents defining jurisdiction. Jurisdiction is taken at the landward edge of the blue line. You can simply put this edge on your survey or, as many surveyors do, you can map the full extent of the line on your survey
