

### **Outfall Reconnaissance Inventory and Dry Weather Flow (DWF) Monitoring**

*Reporting period: March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020 through March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021*

The first step in the field work was to conduct an initial scoping (e.g. field reconnaissance) for all 309 outfall locations indicated in the original data layer of the Town of Huntington's MS4. During the initial scoping the existence of the outfalls were confirmed, associated data was updated, and the best method for monitoring/sampling was determined. Whenever possible, outfalls were monitored directly. However, in a significant number of cases outfalls were submerged all or most of the time. In these cases, Cornell Cooperative Extension of Suffolk County (CCE) completed monitoring from the nearest connecting stormwater structure which is not submerged or monitoring was conducted at low tide.

Of the 309 outfall locations CCE attempted to monitor we determined that 64 had either been removed (typically due to new construction) or were deemed to be something other than a stormwater outfall (e.g. weeping hole in bulkhead/retaining wall) resulting in 245 active stormwater outfalls. Of these 245 active outfalls, 62 exhibited Dry Weather Flow and 14 had Standing Water after a period of 48 hours with no runoff producing rainfall. However, none of these outfalls exhibited any signs of an illicit discharge. These conditions are typically associated with natural freshwater intrusion (groundwater or surface water) or tidal water inundating the system (occasionally mixing with freshwater) and flowing out during low tides.

Outfall data was updated in the field using Collector for ArcGIS, and monitoring data was collected in the field using Survey123 for ArcGIS. At present this data is being managed in CCE's GIS, and can be exported as needed in the desired format. A map of the monitored active outfalls is provided below.
