Huntington Arts Council is seeking an experienced Theatre Technician with a strong background and interest in stage lighting for live music concerts, dance and theatrical performances, and any other show/production involving lighting. Successful candidate will be hired as a seasonal employee by Town of Huntington within Dept. of Parks & Recreation.

As Chief Lighting Technician, will have primary responsibility for maintaining, rigging and operating all lighting equipment for annual eight-plus week Summer Arts Festival, and for other scheduled events and performances at this venue, including Tulip Festival (May), Fall Festival (October) and facility rentals, as needed.

Chief Lighting Technician will work in cooperation with the Director of Performing Arts & Production Manager(s) to plan, coordinate and run all production activity and will become a key team member of Chapin Rainbow Stage Technical Staff. Supervisory experience preferred. Experience in working with touring LD's and productions preferred.

The ideal candidate will:

- Be familiar with and comply with best practices and electrical safety guidelines set by venue and governing agencies such as OSHA
- Be comfortable working safely from heights
- Will have experience in lighting design and the programming of electronic and digital lighting control consoles and equipment.

An understanding of how all types of stage lighting instruments work, including all adjustments and limitations and maintenance, is required. Knowledge of basic hand tools and electrical skills are necessary.

A bachelor's degree in theater arts with concentration in technical stagecraft is preferred. What's most important to us is on-the-job experience including, but not limited to, professional theater lighting and previous production experience.
