

<u>OVERVIEW</u>

- Annual Operating Budget (day to day expenses):
 \$15.3 million
- Annual Capital Budget request: \$1 million
- 113 full time employees; 30 temporary summer hires
- Responsible for maintenance of 178 Town buildings, 200+ vehicles, 75 parking fields, 2 golf courses, 2 ice rinks, approx. 100 ballfields, 80 sports courts, 32 playgrounds and 100+ nature preserves.



MISSION

The Department of General Services is a multifunctional department whose mission is to provide maintenance services for most Town owned properties, facilities, vehicles and equipment.



WORKLOAD

The department's workload is separated into 7 divisions, as follows:

BUILDING MAINTENANCE

- Construction, maintenance and repair of all Town owned buildings & structures.
- Employs skilled professionals in the following trades: electrical, plumbing, carpentry, masonry, painting and general maintenance.

OFF-STREET PARKING

Maintenance, repair, construction and snow removal for:

- Municipal, park, and commuter parking lots and garages
- *Memorial areas, organic gardens, historic cemeteries
- Many other Town facilities



WORKLOAD (cont'd)

VEHICLE MAINTENANCE

- *Maintenance of & repairs to all Town-owned vehicles (except Highway, HART, and Environmental Waste Management).
- *Maintain fuel management system
- Towing of abandoned vehicles as directed by Public Safety

PARKS & GROUNDS MAINTENANCE

- Responsible for care of all parks and other Town owned parcels, including athletic fields, playgrounds and nature preserves
- Performs abandoned property clean-ups as directed by Town Board

DIX HILLS PARK MAINTENANCE

Responsible for maintenance of Dix Hills Park recreational facilities: ice rinks, swimming pool, and other facilities.



WORKLOAD (cont'd)

GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE

Responsible for the maintenance, construction & repair of:

- Crab Meadow Golf Course (18 holes)
- Dix Hills Golf Course (9 holes)

INTER-DEPARTMENTAL SERVICES

- Anages the acquisition & distribution of PPE, office supplies, inter-office mail, USPS mail & packages
- Operation of the print shop
- Custodial services for Town Hall & the Flanagan Center



2020 ACHIEVEMENTS

We continue to try to keep up with our ever-expanding workload by striving to conserve resources and streamline operations. Our major facilities, such as Town Hall, the Flanagan Center, Dix Hills Ice Rink & swimming pool continue to mature, the task of keeping them running with the same or less funding each year is an ever-increasing challenge.

In addition to general maintenance of Town facilities, which is our primary function, we renovated various offices and facilities at Town Hall and the Flanagan Center, and completed some LED and natural gas upgrades.

At the very beginning of the pandemic, our Inter-Departmental Services division proactively sourced and purchased large amounts of PPE & sanitizing devices long before the rush and subsequent shortages, enabling us to continue providing services without disruption. By carefully staggering work hours and shifts, the department never missed a beat and was able to provide safe and clean parks & facilities.



2021 GOALS

Assist with upgrade of new Telephone System
Upgrade various Department offices and facilities
Proceed with the next phase of Flanagan Center roof replacement
Upgrade parking facilities to meet ADA requirements
Complete generator back-up projects for the Flanagan Center and Town Hall.
Bring underground fuel tanks and pumping facilities into
compliance with SC-DOH regulations.
Continue to maintain all facilities in accordance with CDC
guidelines and provide employees and the public with safe
and enjoyable environments.



PERFORMANCE MEASURES

The full integration of the Q Alert program has allowed us a better insight into all of our maintenance operations.

By closely monitoring and quantifying work requests from the public and town employees we have been able to reallocate our assets more effectively improving response time and lowering costs.

Our custodial services have been vastly improved.

Throughout the pandemic, this essential staff was able to learn, adapt and implement the new evolving cleaning procedures necessary to maintaining a safe work environment.
