Operational Responsibilities

☐ Beaches: Lifeguarding, attendants, swim lessons and concessions at eight (8) locations, and the Sgt. Paul Tuozzolo Memorial Spray Park.
Cultural Affairs: Public Art initiative, Summer Arts Festival, Heckscher Museum of Art and
other local non-profit cultural institutions.
Programs: Year-long calendar 100s of activities, programs, lessons, classes, workshops.



2020 Achievements

- * Parks oversees the hiring of all summer personnel at our beaches, all summer recreational programs and the permitting and accreditation of our Lifeguards and EMT's
- *We manage all cultural events through our partners at the Huntington Arts Council and Heckscher Museum
- *Administer approximately \$1 million in annual cultural affairs grants contracts with non-profit community agencies.



2020 Achievements

- □ Parks successfully ran 5 summer day camps, with over 1200 campers and not one positive Covid Test
- Managed beaches at 50% capacity, sold record number of beach passes, did not have one major incident
- ☐ Coordinated the purchase of Mobi-Mats to enable disabled persons better access to Town beaches



2020 Accomplishments

- ☐ Manor #32 replacement of current synthetic ballfield with new synthetic turf.
- Streamline the Rec Card ID and Field Permit acquisition to be fully online.
- □Add Spray Park to Manor Field Park and secured state funding for a new playground.



2020 Accomplishments

- ☐ The Summer Arts Festival was branded the Summer of Hope that saw 17 concerts take place at the Chapin Stage, with a limit to 50 people which was well received, and streamed for viewing at home.
- Worked with IT to create a Formstack to track all data pertinent to running camps for over 600 children.
- Supported the ongoing Movies on the Lawn series with our beach staff



2021 Goals

- Upgrade at Al Walker Park with new basketball courts and play equipment
- Renovation of Veterans Park, new sprinkler system and grass.
- Work with the NY Rangers on the NHL's Girls Recreational Hockey initiative.
